FL-28:TODAY: Phil Ehr To Participate in Key West World AIDS Day Memorial; "We Must Never Again Allow Bigotry to Sabotage the Health of Our Communities."

KEY WEST – Phil Ehr, Democratic candidate for Florida's 28th Congressional District, was scheduled to participate this evening in today's World AIDS Day memorial, including a march from City Hall to the Florida Keys AIDS Memorial.

With a rise in anti-LGBTQ+ bigotry in Tallahassee and Washington led by MAGA extremism, Ehr called for vigilance against the mistakes that compounded the AIDS crisis at its onset and well after.
